- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. 2. Category of Suppliers invited for this Tender

2.1 Class I local Supplier: has local content equal to or more than 50%. Class II local Supplier: has local content equal to or more than 20% but less than 50% Non-Local supplier need not apply.

3. Compliance with Technical Specifications

- 3.1 The quoted product must meet all essential technical specifications outlined in the bid. Non-complian ce will result in the disqualification of bid and no further correspondence will be entertained.
- 3.2 The bidder must not provide vague or generic technical specifications. All specifications must be specific, clearly stated, and supported by relevant datasheets or technical documentation.
- 3.3 The technical specifications of the quoted product must be publicly available in the product brochure or on the manufacturer's website prior to the publication date of the bid.
- 3.4 The bidder must be ready to provide a demonstration of the offered product, if required by the evaluating committee.

4. Mandatory Documents

- 4.1 Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought i n the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum, if any.
- 4.2 Also, bidders are requested to submit only those documents which are specified in the tender/ATC.

- 4.3 Data Sheet of the product(s) offered in the bid, are to be uploaded along with the bid documents. Bu yers can match and verify the Data Sheet with the product specifications offered. In case of any unexplain ed mismatch of technical parameters, the bid is liable for rejection.
- 4.4 Wherever Authorised Distributors/service providers are submitting the bid, Authorisation Form /Certificate with OEM/Original Service Provider details such as name, designation, address, e-mail Id and P hone No. required to be furnished along with the bid. Failure to the same will result in the disqualification of bid without further evaluation.

6. Custom Duty Exemption

6.1 I-HUB QTF is exempt from paying customs duty under Notification No. 51/96, dated 23.07.1996. A Cu stom Duty Exemption Certificate will be provided upon request. However, the Bill of Entry should be on the name of I-HUB QUANTUM TECHNOLOGY FOUNDATION.

7. Payment Terms for the Order

- 7.1 Payment will be made directly to the supplier(s) by NEFT/RTGS/ANY OTHER DIGITAL MODES after the receipt and acceptance of the goods at I-HUB QTF, tested / inspected and found satisfactory with regard to quality, quantity, and specifications ordered for, and after satisfying that the terms and conditions of supply have been fulfilled as per the purchase order / tender.
- 7.2 The payment may also be subject to the receipt of Performance Bank Guarantee (applicable as per t he GeM tender document) within 15 days from the order date, valid for till warranty period + 60 days from the date of installation.
- 7.3 Alternately, for high value orders, a Letter of Credit may be established for 100% of the order value, wherein 90% payment will be released upon presentation of original shipping documents and the remainin g 10% will be released after successful installation, commissioning, and submission of the PBG (if applicable).

8. Fall Clause

11.1 The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU for 3 years befo re the bid opening date. Copies of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in support of having s upplied some quantity during each of the year. 12. Past Project Experience

- 12.1 For fulfilling the experience criteria any one of the following documents may be considered as valid proof for meeting the experience criteria:
- i. Contract copy along with Invoice(s) with self-certification by the bidder that service/supplies against the invoices have been executed.
- ii. Execution certificate by client with contract value.
- iii. Any other document in support of contract execution like Third Party Inspection release note, etc.

13. Purchase Preference (Centre)

13.1 Indian suppliers of this item are not allowed to participate and/ or compete in procurement by some foreign governments. Bidders / products from such countries are not eligible / not allowed to participate in this bid in terms of clause 1 (d) of Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017.

14. Purchase Preference linked with Local Content (PP-LC) Policy

- 14.1 The bid clause regarding "Preference to Make In India products" stands modified in this bid and shal I be governed by the PPLC Policy No. FP-20013/2/2017-FP-PNG dated 17.11.2020 issued by MoP&NG as am ended up to date. Accordingly, bidders with Local Content less than or equal to 20% will be treated as "No n Local Supplier". The prescribed LC shall be applicable on the date of Bid opening. Sanctions on the bidde rs for false / wrong declaration or not fulfilling the Local Content requirement shall be as per the PPLC polic y.
- 14.2 Further following additional provisions are added in the certification and verification of local content provision of the Preference to Make in India clause:
- 14.3 In case of foreign bidder, certificate from the statutory auditor or cost auditor of their own office or subsidiary in India giving the percentage of local content is also acceptable. In case office or subsidiary in I ndia does not exist or Indian office/subsidiary is not required to appoint statutory auditor or cost auditor, c

ertificate from practicing cost accountant or practicing chartered accountant giving the percentage of local content is also acceptable.

- 14.4 Along with Each Invoice: The local content certificate (issued by statutory auditor on behalf of procuring company) shall be submitted along with each invoice raised. However, the % of local content may vary with each invoice while maintaining the overall % of local content for the total work/purchase of the prorata local content requirement. In case, it is not satisfied cumulatively in the invoices raised up to that stage, the supplier shall indicate how the local content requirement would be met in the subsequent stages.
- 14.5 The bidder shall submit an undertaking from the authorized signatory of bidder having the Power of Attorney along with the bid stating the bidder meets the mandatory minimum LC requirement and such un dertaking shall become a part of the contract.

15. Bidder financial standing

16. Warranty

16.1 Warranty period of the supplied products shall be **1 year** from the date of final acceptance of goods or after completion of installation, commissioning & testing of goods (if included in the scope of supply), at I-HUB QTF. 18. Installation

19. Termination of Contract

- 19.1 Without prejudice to Buyer's right to price adjustment by way of discount or any other right or rem edy available to Buyer, Buyer may terminate the Contract or any part thereof by a written notice to the Sel ler. if:
- i. The Seller fails to comply with any material term of the Contract.
- ii. The Seller informs Buyer of its inability to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulat ed Delivery Period or such inability otherwise becomes apparent.
- iii. The Seller fails to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period and/ or to replace/rectify any rejected or defective Material(s) promptly.
- iv. The Seller becomes bankrupt or goes into liquidation.
- v. The Seller makes a general assignment for the benefit of creditors.
- vi. A receiver is appointed for any substantial property owned by the Seller.
- vii. The Seller has misrepresented to Buyer, acting on which misrepresentation Buyer has placed the Pur chase Order on the Seller.

20. Optional Clause

20.1 The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 perce nt of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. - 2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
- 3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
- 4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
- 5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
- 6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
- 7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
- 8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for <u>attached categories</u>, trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

All GeM Sellers / Service Providers are mandated to ensure compliance with all the applicable laws / acts / rules including but not limited to all Labour Laws such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972 etc. Any non-compliance will be treated as breach of contract and Buyer may take suitable actions as per GeM Contract.
